Triathlon success!

Archie and Beth took part in the Club Championship at NYP TriStars in Ripon and Archie came 1st in his age group. He won a magnificent trophy for 'getting the most points in the series.' He enjoyed 'open water swimming at Ripon Racecourse, cycling 4kms and running 2kms.' Beth came third in her age group, loved it all and did everything with a smile on her face. 'My favourite part is the open water swimming because it feels so different.'

Wow Science in Class 3

Children in Class are learning about the human body and the function of its parts. They were able to dissect lamb's hearts to identify the different parts of the heart and reinforce vocabulary. Each group dissected a heart. Grace B said, 'I learnt that the right hand side of the heart takes the deoxygenated blood and then that blood is carried to the lungs to get re-oxygenated, then it travels out of the atrium.' Elliot said, 'I learnt that the right ventricle carries de-oxygenated blood, it gets into the lungs and is re-oxygenated. Blood in the veins goes back into the heart.' Archie learnt 'that the blood goes from your heart into your lungs to get oxygen and goes to the left side which is the stronger. The left ventricle is one of the four chambers of the heart. It is located in the bottom left portion of the heart below the left atrium.' The left hand side of the heart has a stronger muscle because it has to pump the oxygenated blood around the body,' said Matilda.
