Dissecting lamb and ox hearts

Ruby M said, 'I learnt the left ventricle is actually the opposite and it's on the right side. Your heart beats 72 times in a minute and it beats 2.5 billion times by the time you're 66. There are 4 chambers the left atrium, the right atrium the left ventricle and the right ventricle. The heart pumps blood to the lungs, your arteries carry blood away from the heart and you need blood in all parts of your body. The left side is thicker than the right because it has to pump blood to the lungs. The ox heart is really big everyone thought it was a horse heart we wore gloves to put our hands inside to feel first we cut it open so it looked like a book. We put straws in the main arteries and veins so that we could see the chambers. Mrs Whild says that: 'Everybody learnt something new and I was really pleased with 100% effort and progress.
