### Learning experience 1 – due in Monday 11th September 2017

### Learning experience 2 – due in Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2017

This half term we are learning about illusion in art and its mathematical links. Your challenge is to create a collection of art illusions. You might like to start by looking at the work of M.C. Escher. Google optical illusions too. Enjoy your research.

Annotate each illusion with the name of the artist, the name of the piece and the date it was created please. You will be sharing your learning with your partner in class.

### Learning experience 3 – due in on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2017

This week we are researching designers of everyday objects. Have you ever wondered who designed the first paperclip? Postit note? Lego brick? X box game? Stirrups? Shark cage? Bubble wrap? Comb? Chewing gum? Piano?

Choose a product and write a biography of the designer, including a paragraph about the design product. You will need to answer some questions. Why was the product designed that way? When was it made? How much does it cost to produce in the past and now? How much does it sell for now? Who buys the product and why? Write at least 5 paragraphs including high level punctuation and vocabulary. Vary your sentence openers.

### Learning experience 4 – due in on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2017

Draw the United Kingdom. Name 10 cities in a one colour, 10 rivers in another colour and 10 mountains in a different colour. Include a key. Mark on 5 places you have visited with your family. Which is your favourite place to visit? Why?

### Learning experience 5 – due in on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2017

The Year 5 and 6 spelling list is taken from the English National Curriculum and is in your homework book. Over the year we will be learning these. This is your opportunity to start practising!

What is your top tip for learning spellings? What strategies do you have that you could share with your friends?

### Learning experience 6 – due in on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2017

### Learning experience 7 – for half term

We would like you to read over the holidays and enjoy your books! Talk about reading with your family. Ask your family what they like to read and why? Why do they choose particular books? Why do people in general like reading? What is the purpose of reading? There is no need to record anything in your homework book, just see what you learn and enjoy the conversation.

### Learning experience 8 – due in on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2017

In History we are learning about crime and punishment throughout the ages. Your challenge is to find out about crimes committed and punishments during a time period that interests you. You can choose from:

- ❖ The Roman period
- ❖ Anglo-Saxon and Viking period
- ❖ Medieval and Tudor period
- ❖ Victorian times
- ❖ Now

Write 5 paragraphs. Write at least 5 paragraphs including high level punctuation and vocabulary. Vary your sentence starters. A top tip for researching using the internet is to add KS2 in the search, for example; Roman crime and punishment KS2, crime and punishment in Tudor times KS2 etc



You might like to include pictures as visual enhancements to your learning.
