### Learning experience 1 – due in on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2018

### Learning experience 3 – due in on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018

Design and make a World War 1 trench. You might like to create a trench in a shoe box, use junk box modelling or Lego. You may like to use technology. You can showcase your learning in any way you choose but your trench must have the following features: ladder, firing step, sandbags, duckboards, trench supports/trench back, barbed wire and a dug-out for men to live in.

### Learning experience 3 – due in on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018

Research 10 unusual facts about World War 1 e.g. the Germans had leather helmets with a spike on the top (called a pickelhaube) until 1916. Make a list of 10 statistics about World War 1 e.g. 23,000,000 personnel were wounded.

### Learning experience 4 – due in on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2018

Class 3's favourite homework – cooking! This week we would like you to follow a recipe and cook for your family – the only difference is the recipe must be an original wartime recipe from between 1914 and 1918. Think about everything you will need before you start. Make sure you have permission from your family before you start as you may need help with the oven and other items in the kitchen and must stay safe. You must clean the kitchen afterwards too! All good cooks need to do this!
